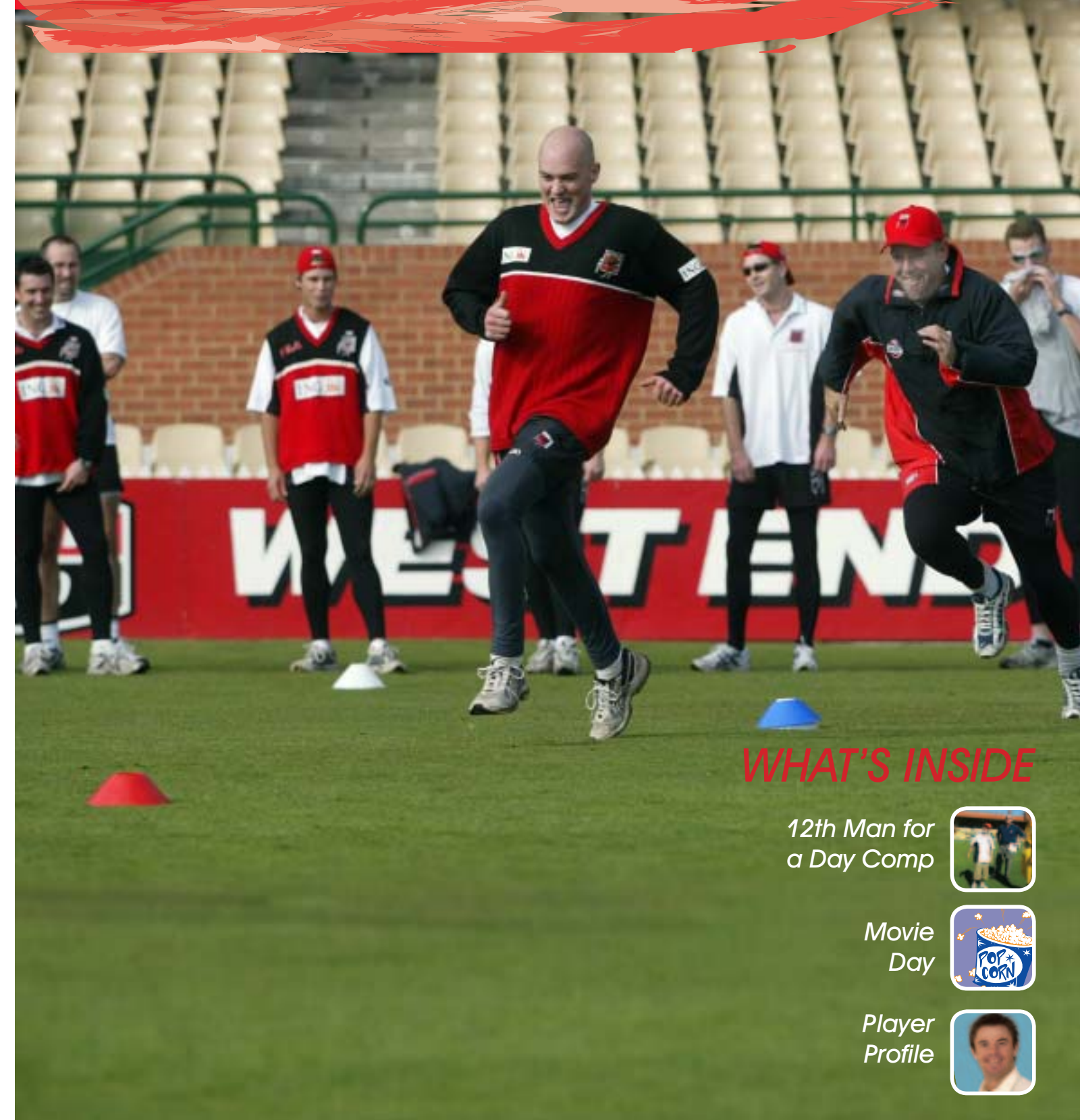

**Pura Cup Points**

Tried to follow the Pura Cup table but not sure how points are allocated? Well now you can follow your favourite team the Redbacks up the Pura table by referring to the following table.

Category	What it means...	Points Awarded
<b>First innings points</b>	The team that scores the most runs in their first innings (whether they bat first or second)	2 (retained even if beaten outright)
<b>Outright win</b>	The team that wins match (whether they win, lose or tie first innings)	6 (maximum points)
<b>Tied match</b>	If both teams finish on equal runs after completing two innings each	3 (irrespective of first innings result)
<b>Tied innings</b>	Equal runs on first innings (and no outright result)	1 each
<b>Outright loss</b>	Team who loses match after a tie in the first innings	1
<b>First innings loss</b>	Team with least amount of runs in the first innings	0
<b>Outright loss</b>	Team who loses match after losing first innings	0
<b>Abandoned/Draw</b>	Abandoned or drawn match with no first innings result	0

**ING RULES**

Did you know that each year the ING Cup one-day domestic competition incorporates unique new rules adding to the excitement of the games? Did you also know that you could benefit from some of these rules?

Following are just a few of the new initiatives in this year's ING competition and an explanation of how you could win just by being at the games...

**Free Hit**

An exciting new playing condition for the ING Cup competition is the Free Hit for the delivery following a "foot-fault" no-ball. The next delivery will become a free hit for whichever batsman is facing it. If the delivery for the free hit is not a legitimate delivery (a no-ball or a wide), then the next delivery becomes a free hit for whichever batsman is facing it.

For any free hit, the striker can only be dismissed under the circumstances that apply for a no-ball even if the delivery for a free hit is called a wide. Field changes are permitted for a free hit. The umpire will indicate a free hit delivery by crossing and re-crossing his wrists above the head.

**Catch the Six**

If a batsman hits a six and a member of the crowd catches the ball, a prize will be awarded to the spectator. The prize begins at \$100 and jackpots by \$100 each game if a catch is not taken, to a maximum of \$1000. (The jackpot applies only to televised games). When a catch is taken by a spectator, the fund returns to the \$100 figure.

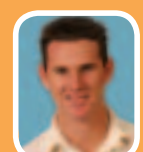
